### The Statistics of Applications Reviewed and Approved is as Follows

- 93.9% of applications reviewed and mailed to NSSAR
- 64.6% of applications approved by NSSAR
- 16.2% of applications received & pended by Georgia Registrar
- 01.3% of applications received & pended by National

The fourth quarter of 2016 flow of applications represented 22.6% of the applications received in 2016. The quantity of pended applications by the Registrar shows a slight decrease in the number of pended applications and still indicates a need for chapter Registrars to review applications preparation procedures.
